
## 'Come & Try' target sports shooting at the SSAA Goolwa Pistol and Shooting Club

The afternoon commences with introduction to our firearms safety first before you can have a "hands on" at either 25m or 50m at paper target shooting. All activities are fully supervised by our Firearms Trainers and Range Officers and are under cover from the weather. Anyone is welcome to participate and have a go.
